

Residential Garbage and Bulk Information



The City of Rockwall has contracted with Republic (formerly known as Allied Waste) for garbage. Republic picks up garbage on Monday/Thursday and Tuesday/Friday, depending on your location in the city. Please place garbage out by 7:00 am.



- Rental of a garbage poly cart at the rate of \$4.69 is optional. You have the option of purchasing a poly cart at Home Depot, Lowes or Wal Mart. Please allow 4 to 6 weeks to receive the rental poly cart.
- If you have an alley please place your bags and or cans in the alley for pickup. If you do not have an alley please place your bags and cans adjacent to your driveway in front. Household garbage should be placed in a bag. If you have a large amount of bags of leaves or grass clippings you should put this out front for bulk pick up.
- We ask that all residents put their garbage out no earlier than 6:00 pm the night before your scheduled pick up day. Please remove your cans no later than 7:00 am the day after your garbage has been picked up.
- Please note that bags or cans weighing more than 35 pounds will not be picked up.

Residential Garbage and Bulk Information

Bulk information:

- Bulk pick up will be Monday through Saturday of the scheduled week. Your schedule will be provided to you at the time you apply for services.
- Items will not be picked up in the alley. All items have to be placed out front for pick up by 7:00 am on Mondays.
- Please do not place items under trees, electric wires, in the street or on top of your water meter.
- Brush includes tree trimmings, leaves, and grass clippings.
- Bulky waste includes stoves, water tanks, washing machines, furniture (to include, tv's and rugs) and other things of this nature.
- Bulk items should contain **no** hazardous waste material or construction material. Rock, excavation dirt, scrap building material or other trash resulting from construction or major remodeling **will not** be removed by Republic Services. Fencing must be no larger than 6' x 3' x 3', no fence post with concrete attached will be accepted, as well as Tires, oil based paint and refrigerants **will not** be accepted.
- Bundles of tree; shrub and brush trimmings should be securely tied together forming an easily handled package not to exceed four feet in length, six inches in diameter, or 50 pounds in weight. Total amount of "bundled" material set out for collection each week per home shall not exceed two cubic yards (6' x 3' x 3').
