



ANNUAL RESIDENTIAL BURN PERMIT Application

The permit will be valid for a period of one year from issuance date. An on-site inspection must be conducted prior to igniting each fire. Permit holder must notify the fire department dispatch center prior to igniting each fire.

Permit Fees: \$25 review fee per year — \$50 On-site inspection (normal hours) — \$150 after hour inspection
Payment due prior to inspection in exact cash or check/money order – payable to City of Rockwall

- 1) Burning shall be conducted in compliance with the following meteorological and timing considerations:
 - a) Begin burning no earlier than one hour after sunrise, end it the same day and no later than one hour before sunset, and make sure that a responsible party is present while the burn is active and the fire is progressing.
 - b) Burning shall not be commenced when surface wind speed is predicted to be less than six miles per hour (mph) (five knots) or greater than 23 mph (20 knots) during the burn period.
 - c) Burning shall not be conducted during periods of actual or predicted persistent low-level atmospheric temperature inversions.
- 2) Only trees, brush, grass, leaves, branch trimmings, or other plant growth may be burned on the property of which the material grew. **The following items shall not be burned:** Garbage, refuse, paper, electrical insulation, treated lumber, plastics, non-wood construction/demolition materials, heavy oils, asphaltic materials, potentially explosive materials, chemical wastes, and items containing natural or synthetic rubber (tires), furniture, carpet, and other decayable and nondecayable waste, including vegetable matter and animal and fish carcasses. This would also include domestic waste such as kitchen garbage, cardboard boxes, packaging, and clothing.
