Deferred Disposition

A 90-day probation period is available by submitting a Deferred Disposition request. You must still pay the amount of the fine for your particular charge which will be collected as a Deferral Fee. CDL license holders are not eligible for this option. If you receive no convictions for any other offense during the probation period, the charge will be dismissed and will not appear on your driving record. If you choose this option you may complete section 5 on the back of the gold copy of your citation and mail it along with your payment to the address provided. You will then receive a form to sign and return so your case can be dismissed at the end of your probation period.

To be eligible for this option you must not have been on deferred disposition in the City of Rockwall for 12 months preceding the violation. The probation period can be up to 180 days.

If you were exceeding the speed limit by more that 24 miles over the limit you must set a court date for this option.
