## **ORDINANCE NO. 10-01**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKWALL, TEXAS, PROVIDING FOR THE EXTENSION OF CERTAIN BOUNDARY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF ROCKWALL, TEXAS AND THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN TERRITORY CONSISTING OF 288.80 ACRES OF LAND, WHICH SAID TERRITORY LIES ADJACENT TO AND ADJOINS THE PRESENT BOUNDARY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF ROCKWALL, TEXAS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, Public Hearings were held before the governing body of the City of Rockwall, Texas, where all interested persons were provided with an opportunity to be heard, on the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of November, 2009, at 6:00 p.m. and on the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of November, 2009, at 6:30 p.m. at City Hall, 385 S. Goliad, Rockwall, Texas said dates being not more than forty (40) days nor less than twenty (20) days prior to the institution of annexation proceedings, on the proposed annexation of the following described territories:

BEING a 316.91-acre tract of land situated in the W.M. Dalton Survey, Abstract No. 72, Rockwall, Rockwall County, Texas and being more particularly described by metes and bounds as follows:

BEGINNING at a point for a corner in the South line of Cornelius Road, said point being the Northwesterly most corner of said tract;

THENCE N 89° 20'17" E, along said South line of Cornelius Road for a distance of 4558.04 feet to a point for a corner at the intersection of the South line of Cornelius Road and the West line of FM 549 (a 100' ROW);

THENCE S 01° 17'00" E, departing said South line and following along said West line of FM 549, for a distance of 98.27 feet to a point for a corner;

THENCE continuing along the said West line of FM 549 for the following calls:

S 17° 00' 00" W, a distance of 28.40 feet to a point of curvature of a circular curve to the left, having a central angle of 18° 17' 00", a radius of 813.94 feet and a tangent of 130.98 feet;

THENCE along said curve to the left, for an arc distance of 259.73 feet to a point of tangency;

S 01° 17' 00" E for a distance of 1630.61 feet, to a point of curvature, of a circular curve to the right, having a central angle of 10° 06' 00", a radius of 1382.39 feet, and a tangent of 122.16 feet:

THENCE along said curve to the right, for an arc distance of 243.69 feet to a point of tangency;

S 08° 49' 00" W for a distance of 241.25 feet, to a point for a corner;

S 04° 00' 00" W, for a distance of 34.23 feet to a point for a corner:

S 28° 19' 00" W, for a distance of 164.09 feet to a point for a corner in the South line of State Highway No. 66 (SH 66) (a 60' ROW);

THENCE along the said South line of SH 66 for the following calls:

S 89° 19' 49" W, a distance of 992.76 feet to a point for a corner:

S 89° 07' 29" W, a distance of 2063.13 feet to a point of curvature of a circular curve to

the left, having a central angle of 11° 05' 24", a radius of 905.00 feet, and a tangent of 87.86 feet;

THENCE along said curve to the left, for an arc distance of 175.17 feet to a point of tangency;

S 78° 02' 05" W, for a distance of 127.10 feet to a point of curvature of a circular curve to the right, having a central angle of 11° 17' 49", a radius of 990.00 feet, and a tangent of 97.92 feet:

THENCE along said curve to the right, for an arc distance of 195.20 feet to a point of tangency;

S 89° 19' 54" W, a distance of 931.11 feet to a point of curvature, of a circular curve to the right, having a central angle of 12° 40' 59", a radius of 946.00 feet, and a tangent of 105.13 feet:

THENCE along said curve to the right, for an arc distance of 209.41 feet to a point of tangency;

N 77° 59' 07" W, a distance of 68.09 feet to a point of curvature, of a circular curve to the left, having a central angle of 12° 38' 49", a radius of 800.00 feet, and a tangent of 88.65 feet:

THENCE along said curve to the left, for an arc distance of 176.58 feet to a point of tangency;

S 89° 22' 04" W, a distance of 431.67 feet to a point for a corner;

THENCE N 00° 37' 56" W, departing said South line of SH 66 for a distance of 60.00 feet to a point for a corner in the North line of said SH 66;

THENCE N 89° 22' 04" E, along said North line of SH 66, for a distance of 317.69 feet to a point for a corner, said point being at the intersection of the said North line of SH 66 and the East City Limits line;

THENCE N 00° 56' 14" W, departing said North line of SH 66 and following along the said East City Limits line of Rockwall, for a distance of 2409.60 feet to a point for a corner;

THENCE N 89° 52' 56" E, for a distance of 660.36 feet to a point for a corner:

THENCE N 00° 35' 30" E, for a distance of 218.64 feet to the Point of Beginning and containing 316.91 acres (13,804,600 square feet) of land more or less, save and except previously annexed properties as described in City of Rockwall Ordinance No. 07-36 (18.15 ac) and Ordinance No. 09-02 (9.96 ac). The total remaining acreage to be annexed as shown on Exhibit A is 288.80 acres (12,580,128.00 square feet) of land more or less, with "Tract 1" being 285.85-Acres and "Tract 2" Rest Haven Funeral Homes Inc. being 2.95-Acres.

The above description to follow all existing City of Rockwall City Limit boundaries where noted.

**WHEREAS**, notice of such public hearings were published in a newspaper having general circulation in the City of Rockwall, Texas and in the territory described herein on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2009, and posted on the City of Rockwall Internet site on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2009, said dates being not more than twenty (20) days nor less than ten (10) days prior to the dates of such public hearings; and

WHEREAS, the territory lies adjacent to and adjoins the present boundaries of the City of Rockwall, Texas; and

WHEREAS, the territory above contains 288,80-acres:

# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKWALL, TEXAS:

That the above recitals are hereby found to be true and correct and Section 1. incorporated herein for all purposes.

Section 2. The land and territory more specifically described herein as Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof, and containing 288.80 acres which is adjacent to and adjoining the present boundaries of the City of Rockwall. Texas, is hereby added and annexed to the City of Rockwall, Texas and said territory as described herein shall hereafter be included within the boundary limits of the City of Rockwall, Texas and the present boundary limits of the City at the various points contiguous to the areas as described above, are altered and amended so as to include said area within the corporate limits of the City.

Section 3. That the official map of the City is hereby amended to reflect the addition of the property described herein.

Section 4. The above described territory and the acres so annexed shall be a part of the City of Rockwall, Texas, and the inhabitants thereof, if any, shall be entitled to all of the rights and privileges of all citizens and shall be bound by the acts, ordinances, resolutions and regulations of the City of Rockwall, Texas.

Section 5. That the Service Plan for the annexation area, which was made available for public inspection at the Public Hearings, is hereby approved with a copy of said plan being attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes and labeled Exhibit "B."

That this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its Section 6. passage and approval, in accordance with applicable law and the charter of the City of Rockwall, Texas.



## SURVEY ABSTRACT AND COUNTY:

BEING a 288.80-acre tract of land situated in the W. M. Dalton Survey, Abstract No. 72, Rockwall, Rockwall County, Texas.

# DATE OF ADOPTION OF ANNEXATION ORDINANCE: January 4, 2010

Municipal services to the acreage described above shall be furnished by or on behalf of the City of Rockwall, Texas, at the following levels and in accordance with the following schedule:

### A. Police Services:

- 1. Patrolling, responses to calls, and other routine police services will be provided on the effective date of annexation.
- As development and construction commence within this area, sufficient police
  personnel and equipment will be provided to continue to furnish the area the
  level of police services consistent with police services available in other parts
  of the City with land uses and population densities similar to those projected in
  the annexed area.

#### B. Fire Services

- 1. Fire protection by the present personnel and the present equipment of the fire Department will be provided to this area on the effective date of annexation.
- As development and construction commences within this area, sufficient fire
  personnel and equipment will be provided to continue to furnish the area the
  level of fire services consistent with fire service available in other parts of the
  City with land uses and population densities similar to those projected in the
  annexed area.

# C. Health and Code Compliance Services

- Enforcement of the City's health ordinances and regulations including, but not limited to, weed and brush ordinances, junked and abandoned vehicle ordinances, food handlers ordinances and animal control ordinances, shall be provided within this area on the effective date of the annexation ordinance. These ordinances and regulations will be enforced by existing personnel.
  - Complaints of ordinance or regulation violations within this area will be responded and investigated by existing personnel beginning with the effective date of the annexation ordinance.
- The City's building, plumbing, electrical, gas heating, air conditioning and all other construction codes will be enforced within this area beginning with the effective date of the annexation ordinance. Existing personnel will be used to provide these services.
- 3. The City's zoning, subdivision, and other ordinances shall be enforced in this area beginning on the effective date of the annexation ordinance.
- 4. All inspection services furnished by the City of Rockwall, but not mentioned above, will be provided to this area beginning on the effective date of the annexation ordinance. Any property owner or his/her assigns who in good faith has a new building or structure, as defined in the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance, under construction on the effective date of annexation shall be exempted from these inspections for that building or structure under construction for a period of one year from the effective date of annexation. For the purpose of this ordinance "under construction" shall mean any work that requires a building permit from the City of Rockwall.
- As development and construction commence within this area, sufficient personnel will be provided to continue to furnish this area the same level of Health and Code compliance services as are furnished throughout the City.

# D. Planning and Zoning Services

The planning and zoning jurisdiction of the City will extend to this area on the
effective date of the annexation ordinance. City planning will thereafter
encompass this property, and it shall be entitled to consideration for zoning in
accordance with the City's Comprehensive Plan, Zoning Ordinance,
Landscape Ordinance and Code of Ordinances.

# E. Recreation and Leisure Services

- Residents of this property may utilize all existing recreational and leisure services facilities and sites throughout the City beginning with the effective date of the annexation ordinance.
- Existing parks, playgrounds, swimming pools and other recreation and leisure facilities within this property shall, upon dedication to and acceptance by the City, be maintained and operated by the City of Rockwall.

## F. Solid Waste Collection

1. Solid waste collection shall be provided to the property owner in accordance with existing City policies as to frequency and charges, beginning on the effective date of annexation except for properties that are served by a privately owned solid waste management service provider. Such properties will be allowed to continue private service for a period of two years from the effective date of annexation at which time the property will be required to begin service with a franchised solid waste contractor within the City of Rockwall.

## G. Streets

- 1. The City of Rockwall's existing policies with regard to street maintenance, applicable throughout the entire City, shall apply to this property beginning within 60 days of the effective date of the annexation ordinance.
- As development, improvements or construction of streets to the City standards commence within this property, the policies of the City of Rockwall with regard to impact fees and participation in the cost thereof, acceptance upon completion, and maintenance after completion, shall apply.
- The same level of maintenance shall be provided to streets within this property that have been accepted by the City of Rockwall as is provided to like City streets throughout the City.

#### H. Water Services

- Connection to existing City water mains for water services for domestic, commercial and industrial use within this property will be provided in accordance with existing City policies. Upon connection to existing mains, water will be provided at rates established by City ordinance for such services throughout the City.
- 2. Water mains of the City will be extended in accordance with provisions of the Code of Ordinances and other applicable ordinances and regulations. City participation in the costs of these extensions shall be in accordance with applicable City ordinances and regulations and will be provided as otherwise available in other parts of the City with topography, land uses, population densities similar to those reasonably contemplated or projected in the annexed area.
- 3. Water mains which are within the annexed area and are owned and operated by the City shall be maintained beginning with the effective date of the annexation ordinance or upon acquisition by the City.
- 4. Private water lines within this property shall be maintained by their owners, in accordance with existing policies applicable throughout the City.

# I. Sanitary Sewer Services

- Connections to existing City sanitary sewer mains for sanitary sewage service in this area will be provided in accordance with the existing City policies. Upon connection, sanitary sewage service will be provided at rates established by City ordinances for such services throughout the City.
- Sanitary sewer mains and/or lift stations which are within the annexed area and are connected to City mains shall be maintained by the City of Rockwall beginning with the effective date of the annexation ordinance or upon acquisition by the City.
- 3. Sanitary sewer mains of the City will be extended in accordance with the provisions of the Code of Ordinances and engineering standards and other applicable ordinances and regulations. City participation in the costs of these extensions shall be in accordance with applicable City ordinances and regulations and will be provided as otherwise availably in other parts of the City with topography, land uses, and population densities similar to those reasonably contemplated or projected in the area.
- 4. Previously granted exceptions to the requirements of connections to the city's sanitary sewer treatment system shall be continued until such alternate systems are determined to no longer function to meet the sanitary sewer needs of the subdivision granted the exception.

#### J. Public Utilities

1. Other public utilities will be provided by the City's franchisee or a provider holding a certificate of convenience issued by the state to serve that area.

## K. Miscellaneous

1. General municipal administration services of the City shall be available to the annexed area beginning with the effective date of the annexation ordinance.
