AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ROCKWALL, TEXAS, AMENDING THE COMPREHENSIVE ZONING ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ROCKWALL, AS HERETOFORE AMENDED, SO AS TO GRANT A CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT FOR A STRUCTURE WITH LESS THAN 100% NONCOMBUSTIBLE STRUCTURAL MATERIALS AND LESS THAN 90% MASONRY FACADES ON A TRACT OF LAND DESCRIBED MORE FULLY HEREIN; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED THE SUM OF TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00) FOR EACH OFFENSE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Commission of the City of Rockwall and the governing body of the City of Rockwall, in compliance with
the laws of the State of Texas and the ordinances of the City of Rockwall,
have given the requisite notices by publication and otherwise, and have
held a joint public hearing and afforded a full and fair hearing to all
property owners generally and to all persons interested in and situated
in the affected area, and in the vicinity thereof, the governing body,
in the exercise of its legislative discretion, has concluded that the
Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance of the City of Rockwall should be amended
as follows: NOW, THEREFORE,

SECTION 1. That the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance of the City of Rockwall, Texas, as heretofore amended, be and the same is hereby amended by amending the Zoning Map of the City of Rockwall so as to grant a Conditional Use Permit for a structure with less than 100% noncombustible structural materials and less than 90% masonry facades on the tract of land described as M. J. Barksdale Survey No. 11.

SECTION 2. There shall be no time limit for this Conditional Use

SECTION 3. That the above described tract of land shall be used only in the manner and for the purposes provided for by the Comprehensive toning Ordinance of the City of Rockwall, as heretofore amended, and as amended herein by the granting of this zoning change.

SECTION 4. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be subject to the same penalty as provided for in the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance of the City of Rockwall, as heretofore amended, and as amended hereby, and upon conviction shall be punished by a penalty of fine not to exceed the sum of Two Hundred Dollars

(\$200.00) for each offense, and each and every day such offense shall continue shall be deemed to constitute a separate offense.

Perty requires classification so as to grant a Conditional Use Permit for a structure with less than 100% noncombustible structural materials and less than 90% masonry facades in order to permit its proper development and in order to protect the public interest and general welfare of the City of Rockwall, such requirement creates an urgency and an emermency in the preservation of the public welfare and requires that this ordinance take effect immediately from and after its passage and the publication of the caption of said ordinance, as the law in such cases provides.
