#### ORDINANCE NO 05-11

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKWALL, TEXAS AMENDING THE UNIFIED DEVELOPMENT CODE OF THE CITY OF ROCKWALL AND ORDINANCE NO 99-51 AS PREVIOUSLY AMENDED SO AS TO AMEND AND EXPAND THE CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT LOCATED AT 1990 I-30 EAST FOR A TRUCK STOP CORRECTING THE OFFICIAL ZONING MAP PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY OF FINE NOT TO EXCEED THE SUM OF TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$2,000) FOR EACH OFFENSE, PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE, PROVIDING FOR A REPEALER CLAUSE, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS the City has received a request from Sam Ellis for an amendment to Ordinance No 99-51 to expand the Conditional Use Permit for a 'Truck Stop' and

WHEREAS the Planning and Zoning Commission of the City of Rockwall and the governing body of the City of Rockwall in compliance with the laws of the State of Texas and the ordinances of the City of Rockwall have given the requisite notices by publication and otherwise and have held public hearings and afforded a full and fair hearing to all property owners generally and to all persons interested in and situated in the affected area and in the vicinity thereof and the governing body in the exercise of its legislative discretion has concluded that the Unified Development Code of the City of Rockwall should be amended as follows

# NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKWALL, TEXAS

<u>Section 1.</u> That the Unified Development Code of the City of Rockwall and Ordinance No 99-51 as previously amended be and the same are hereby amended by amending the zoning map of the City of Rockwall so as to expand the Conditional Use Permit located at 1990 I-30 East for a 'Truck Stop

<u>Section 2.</u> That the property described herein shall be used only in the manner and for the purposes provided for in the Unified Development Code of the City of Rockwall as previously amended as amended herein by granting of this zoning change and as may be amended in the future and subject to the following additional conditions

- 1 The CUP is amended subject to the following conditions
  - a. Any significant change in the approved site plan (Exhibit A') must be submitted for approval by the Commission and the City Council
  - **b** TXDOT Permit shall be required for any driveway improvements

**Section 3.** That the official zoning map of the City be corrected to reflect the changes in zoning described herein

Section 4. Any person firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be punished by a penalty of fine not to exceed the sum of TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$2 000 00) for each offense and each and every day such offense shall continue shall be deemed to constitute a separate offense


Section 5. If any section or provision of this ordinance or the application of that section or provision to any person firm corporation situation or circumstance is for any reason judged invalid the adjudication shall not affect any other section or provision of this ordinance or the application of any other section or provision to any other person firm corporation situation or circumstance nor shall adjudication affect any other section or provision of the Unified Development Code of the City of Rockwall Texas and the City Council declares that it would have adopted the valid portions and applications of the ordinance without the invalid parts and to this end the provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

**Section 6.** That all ordinances of the City of Rockwall in conflict with the provisions of this be and the same are hereby repealed and all other ordinances of the City of Rockwall not in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

**Section 7.** That this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and the publication of the caption of said ordinance as the law in such cases provides


