ORDINANCE NO. 60-04

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ROCKWALL, TEXAS, AMENDING THE COMPREHENSIVE ZONING ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ROCKWALL AS HERETOFORE AMENDED SO AS TO GRANT A CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT FOR A 203'-6" CELLULAR TOWER WITHIN THE COMMERCIAL ZONING DISTRICT TO BE LOCATED ON A TRACT OF LAND DESCRIBED HEREIN; PROVIDING FOR SPECIAL CONDITIONS; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY OF FINE NOT TO EXCEED THE SUM OF TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$2,000.00) FOR EACH OFFENSE; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A REPEALER CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, A Conditional Use Permit for a cellular tower in a "C" – Commercial zoning classification has been requested by Rulon Anderson on behalf of Voice Stream Wireless for the property described on Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Commission of the City of Rockwall and the governing body of the City of Rockwall, in compliance with the laws of the State of Texas and the ordinances of the City of Rockwall, have given the requisite notices by publication and otherwise, and have held public hearings and afforded a full and fair hearing to all property owners generally, and to all persons interested in and situated in the affected area and in the vicinity thereof, the governing body in the exercise of its legislative discretion has concluded that the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance of the City of Rockwall should be amended as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Rockwall, Texas:

Section 1. That the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance of the City of Rockwall, as heretofore amended, be and the same is hereby amended so as to grant a Conditional Use Permit for a 203'-6"cellular tower within the "C" – Commercial zoning classification on the property described on Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Section 2. That the Conditional Use Permit shall be subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The permit is granted under Commercial (C) for the purposes of allowing only what is described under Ordinance 83-23, Section 2.12, Part C-4 and C-11 for the property as described on Exhibit "A".
- 2. Approval by the City Engineer of the engineering plans prior to construction.
- 3. All weather road; grading plan of said road with the engineering plans

- 4. No "fill" allowed in the floodplain
- 5. Other carriers to be allowed to co-locate on this cellular tower structure
- 6. Any lighting of the site shall be subject to approval of a Lighting Plan.
- 7. Approval of an electrical/building permit by the City Building Official prior to construction.
- Section 3. That the above described tract of land shall be used only in the manner and for the purposes provided for in the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance of the City of Rockwall as heretofore amended, as amended herein by granting of this Conditional Use Permit and as may be amended in the future.
- That all ordinances of the City of Rockwall in conflict with the Section 4. provisions of this ordinance, and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of that conflict.
- Any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions of this Section 5. ordinance shall be deemed quilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be punished by a penalty of fine not to exceed the sum of TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$2,000.00) for each offence and each and every day such offense shall continue shall be deemed to constitute a separate offense.
- If any section, paragraph, or provision of this ordinance or the application of that section, paragraph, or provision to any person, firm, corporation or situation is for any reason judged invalid, the adjudication shall not affect any other section, paragraph, or provision of this ordinance or the application of any other section, paragraph or provision to any other person, firm, corporation or situation, nor shall adjudication affect any other section, paragraph, or provision of the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance No. 83-23 of the City of Rockwall, Texas, and the City Council declares that it would have adopted the valid portions and applications of the ordinance without the invalid parts and to this end the provisions for this ordinance are declared to be severable.

That this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its Section 7. passage and the publication of the caption of said ordinance as the law in such cases provides.
