ORDINANCE NO. <u>06-48</u>

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKWALL, TEXAS, AMENDING THE UNIFIED DEVELOPMENT CODE OF THE CITY OF ROCKWALL, AS PREVIOUSLY AMENDED, SO AS TO GRANT A SPECIFIC USE PERMIT (SUP) WITHIN THE (SF-10) SINGLE-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT ALLOWING FOR A CARPORT (RESIDENTIAL) NOT MEETING THE STANDARDS IN ARTICLE IV, SECTION 2.1.2 OF THE UNIFIED DEVELOPMENT CODE, ON A TRACT LOCATED AT 711 STILLWATER DRIVE, BEING LOT 8, BLOCK K, STONEBRIDGE MEADOWS PHASE 5; PROVIDING FOR SPECIAL CONDITIONS; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY OF FINE NOT TO EXCEED THE SUM OF TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$2,000.00) FOR EACH OFFENSE; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A REPEALER CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, a request has been made by Rhonda Wells for a Specific Use Permit allowing for a Carport (Residential) not meeting the standards in Article IV, Section 2.1.2 of the Unified Development Code, on a tract located at 711 Stillwater Drive, being Lot 8, Block K, Stonebridge Meadows Phase 5, City and County of Rockwall, Texas; and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Commission of the City of Rockwall and the governing body of the City of Rockwall, in compliance with the laws of the State of Texas and the ordinances of the City of Rockwall, have given the requisite notices by publication and otherwise, and have held public hearings and afforded a full and fair hearing to all property owners generally, and to all persons interested in and situated in the affected area and in the vicinity thereof, the governing body in the exercise of its legislative discretion has concluded that the Unified Development Code of the City of Rockwall should be amended as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKWALL, TEXAS:

Section 1. That the Unified Development Code of the City of Rockwall, as heretofore amended, be and the same is hereby amended so as to grant a Specific Use Permit allowing for a Carport (Residential) not meeting the standards in Article IV, Section 2.1.2 of the Unified Development Code, on a tract located at 711 Stillwater Drive, being Lot 8, Block K, Stonebridge Meadows Phase 5, City and County of Rockwall, Texas; and

Section 2. That the Specific Use Permit shall be subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The building will comply with the approved site plan attached herein as Exhibit "A" and the approved elevations attached herein as Exhibit "B."
- 2. Owners to screen proposed structure from Stonebridge Drive with a combination of a lattice trellis adhered to the posts of the proposed carport and evergreen landscaping such as Wisteria vines or shrubs.
- 3. The City Council reserves the right to review the Specific Use Permit granted herein upon the expiration of one (1) year from the date hereof.

- **Section 3.** That all ordinances of the City of Rockwall in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance be, and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of that conflict.
- **Section 4.** Any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be punished by a penalty of fine not to exceed the sum of TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$2,000.00) for each offence and each and every day such offense shall continue shall be deemed to constitute a separate offense.
- **Section 5.** If any section or provision of this ordinance or the application of that section or provision to any person, firm, corporation, situation or circumstance is for any reason judged invalid, the adjudication shall not affect any other section or provision of this ordinance or the application of any other section or provision to any other person, firm, corporation, situation or circumstance, and the City Council declares that it would have adopted the valid portions and applications of the ordinance without the invalid parts and to this end the provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
- **Section 6.** That this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and the publication of the caption of said ordinance as the law in such cases provides.
