ORDINANCE NO. <u>07-26</u>

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKWALL, TEXAS, AMENDING THE UNIFIED DEVELOPMENT CODE OF THE CITY OF ROCKWALL, TEXAS, AS PREVIOUSLY AMENDED, SO AS TO GRANT A SPECIFIC USE PERMIT TO ALLOW FOR A "MOTOR VEHICLE DEALERSHIP, NEW" ON AN 8.686-ACRE TRACT OF LAND KNOWN AS PART OF TRACT 2, ABSTRACT 134, J. LOCKHART SURVEY AND TRACT 3, ABSTRACT 2, J.M. ALLEN SURVEY, AND MORE SPECIFICALLY SHOWN IN EXHIBIT "A"; PROVIDING FOR SPECIAL CONDITIONS; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY OF FINE NOT TO EXCEED THE SUM OF TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$2,000.00) FOR EACH OFFENSE; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A REPEALER CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, a Specific Use Permit for a "Motor Vehicle Dealership, New" within the (PD-10) Planned Development No. 10 District and (C) Commercial district has been requested by Gary DeFrain of The Cambridge Companies, Inc., on an 8.686-acre tract of land known as part of Tract 2, Abstract 134, J. Lockhart Survey and Tract 3, Abstract 2, J.M. Allen Survey, and more specifically shown in Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Commission of the City of Rockwall and the governing body of the City of Rockwall, in compliance with the laws of the State of Texas and the ordinances of the City of Rockwall, have given the requisite notices by publication and otherwise, and have held public hearings and afforded a full and fair hearing to all property owners generally, and to all persons interested in and situated in the affected area and in the vicinity thereof, the governing body in the exercise of its legislative discretion has concluded that the Unified Development Code of the City of Rockwall should be amended as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKWALL, TEXAS:

- **Section 1.** That the Unified Development Code of the City of Rockwall, as heretofore amended, be and the same is hereby amended so as to grant a Specific Use Permit for a "Motor Vehicle Dealership, New" within the (PD-10) Planned Development No. 10 District and (C) Commercial on an 8.686-acre tract of land known as part of Tract 2, Abstract 134, J. Lockhart Survey and Tract 3, Abstract 2, J.M. Allen Survey, and more specifically shown in Exhibit "A"; and
- **Section 2.** That the Specific Use Permit shall be subject to the conditions set forth in **Article V, Section 4.5, Commercial District** of the City of Rockwall Unified Development Code (Ord. No. 04-38) as heretofore amended and as may be amended in the future, and shall be subject to the additional following additions:
 - 1. Approval of the Specific Use Permit (SUP) is for the proposed land use only (i.e. "Motor Vehicle Dealership, New").
 - 2. Future site plan submittal and approval shall be required, including Architectural Review and adherence to all standards specified in the IH-30 Overlay district and other sections of the Unified Development Code.

- 3. Any variance to the IH-30 Overlay district or other section of the Unified Development shall be considered at the time of site plan approval, including requirements for cross access, building design and materials, and any other site development requirements.
- 4. The SUP shall expire if development has not commenced within three (3) years from the approval date of the SUP ordinance.
- **Section 3.** That the official zoning map of the City be corrected to reflect the changes in zoning described herein.
- **Section 4.** That all ordinances of the City of Rockwall in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance be, and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of that conflict.
- **Section 5.** Any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be punished by a penalty of fine not to exceed the sum of TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$2,000.00) for each offence and each and every day such offense shall continue shall be deemed to constitute a separate offense.
- **Section 6.** If any section, paragraph, or provision of this ordinance or the application of that section, paragraph, or provision to any person, firm, corporation or situation is for any reason judged invalid, the adjudication shall not affect any other section, paragraph, or provision of this ordinance or the application of any other section, paragraph or provision to any other person, firm, corporation or situation, nor shall adjudication affect any other section, paragraph, or provision of the Unified Development Code No. 04-38 of the City of Rockwall, Texas, and the City Council declares that it would have adopted the valid portions and applications of the ordinance without the invalid parts and to this end the provisions for this ordinance are declared to be severable.
- **Section 7.** That this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and the publication of the caption of said ordinance as the law in such cases provides.


