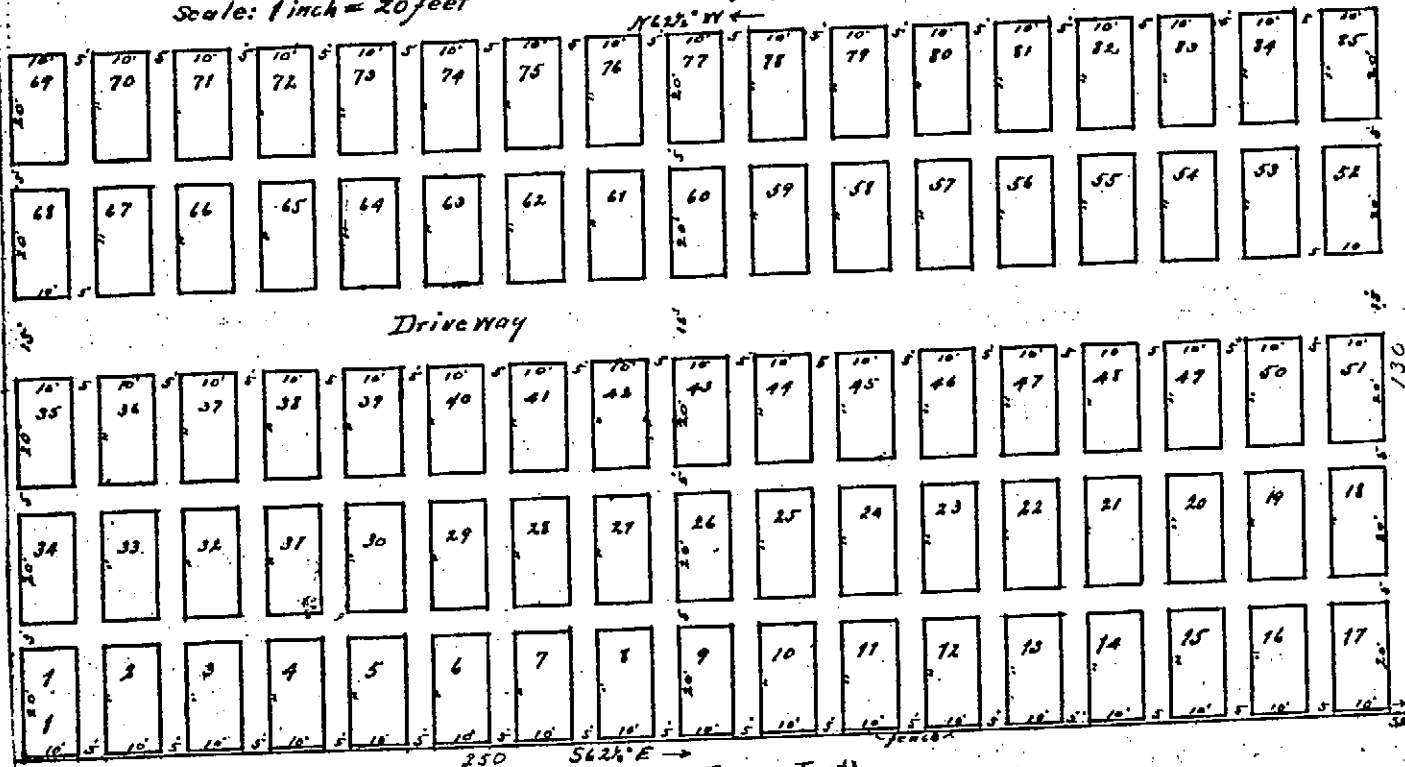


PLAT made for Rockwall Colored Burial Club of their Cemetery
