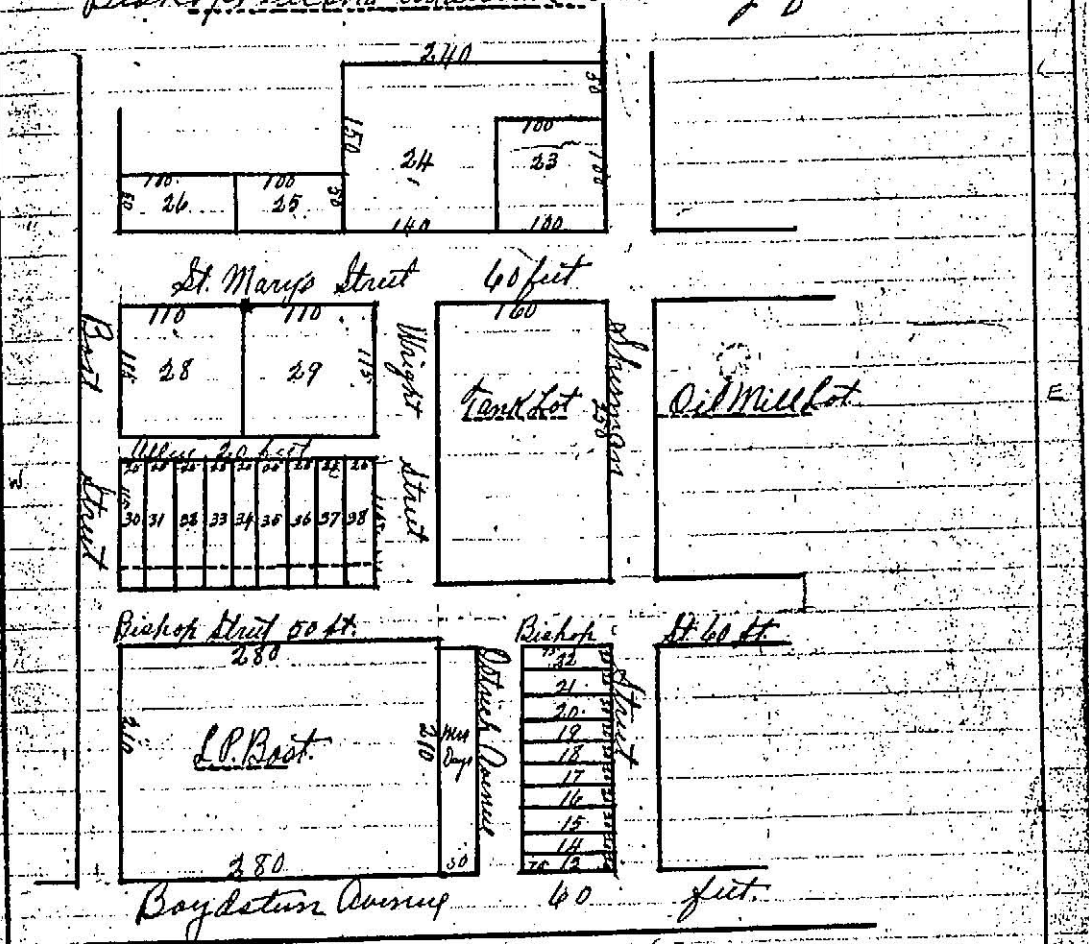


Bishop's Second Addition To the City of Rockwall

The above map or plat represents the second addition of W.C. Bishop to the City of Rockwall, and is to be known as "Bishop's Second Addition" to the City of Rockwall, and contains the tracts of land purchased by said Bishop from L.P. Best, W.H. Hassitt and the American Surety Company. The tracts marked L.P. Best, Mrs. Day, Tank Lot and Oil Mill Lot is not a part of this addition, and does not belong to the said Bishop but are placed on this plat to show the surrounding property. The figures on the sides and ends of the lots show the dimensions in feet. The figures on the lots show the number of the lot. The dotted line across the south ends of lots no 30 to 38 represents the building line, and which line is 70 feet north of the south line of said lots. It is here stipulated that no building or structure of any kind shall ever be placed south of said line. The street and the alley shown on the map or plat is here donated and dedicated to the use of the public.
