

STATE OF TEXAS § COUNTY OF ROCKWALL §

WHEREAS, DREES-STANDARD PACIFIC NO. II, L.C., is the owner of a tract of land situated in the NATHAN BUTLER SURVEY, ABSTRACT NO. 21, in the City of Rockwall, Rockwall County, Texas, and being part of a called 47.91 acre tract of land described in a deed from Hillwood Shores, L.P. to Drees-Standard Pacific No. II, L.C., recorded in Volume 1755, Page 101 of the Deed Records of Rockwall County, Texas, and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at A 1/2-inch iron rod set for a corner being the most northwesterly corner of Hillside Phase 3 at the Shores, an addition to the City of Rockwall according to the plat thereof recorded in Cabinet D, Slides 177 & 178, of the map Records of Rockwall County, Texas;

THENCE Southerly, along the westerly boundary of said Hillside Phase 3, the following:

South 00 degrees 52 minutes 31 seconds East, a distance of 189.88 feet to a 1/2-inch iron rod set for a corner on a non-tangent curve to the left;

Easterly, along the curve to the left which has a chord that bears North 84 degrees 57 minutes 03 seconds East for 56.97 feet, a central angle of 03 degrees 26 minutes 11 seconds and a radius of 950.00 feet, for an arc distance of 56.98 feet to a 1/2-inch iron rod set for a corner on another non-tangent curve to the left for the end of said curve:

Southeasterly, along the curve to the left which has a chord that bears South 20 degrees 43 minutes 10 seconds East for 395.77 feet, a central angle of 42 degrees 10 minutes 29 seconds and a radius of 550.00 feet, for an arc distance of 404.85 feet to a 1/2-inch iron rod set for a corner at the beginning of a tangent curve to the right for the end of said curve:

Southeasterly, along the curve to the right which has a chord that bears South 39 degrees 05 minutes 37 seconds East for 33.61 feet, a central angle of 05 degrees 25 minutes 35 seconds and a radius of 355.00 feet, for an arc distance of 33.62 feet to a 1/2-inch iron rod set for a corner at the end of said curve:

South 24 degrees 24 minutes 19 seconds East, a distance of 50.00 feet to a 1/2-inch iron rod set for a corner on a non-tangent curve to the left;

Northeasterly, along the curve to the left which has a chord that bears North 63 degrees 17 minutes 05 seconds East for 34.26 feet, a central angle of 04 degrees 37 minutes 11 seconds and a radius of 425.00 feet, for an arc distance of 34.27 feet to a 1/2-inch iron rod set for a corner at the end of said curve:

South 29 degrees 01 minutes 31 seconds East, a distance of 120.01 feet to a 1/2-inch iron rod set for a corner being the southerly corner of said Hillside Phase 3, said corner also being in the northwesterly boundary line of Crestview Phase 2 The Shores, an addition to the city of Rockwall according to the plat thereof recorded in cabinet d, slide 13 & 14 of the map records of Rockwall County, texas;

THENCE South 60 degrees 39 minutes 55 seconds West, departing the boundary of said Hillside Phase 3 and along the northwesterly boundary of said Crestview Phase 2 and the northwesterly boundary of Crestview Phase 3 an addition to the city of Rockwall according to the plat thereof recorded in cabinet d, slide 171 & 172 of the map records of Rockwall County, Texas, a distance of 605.00 feet to a 1/2-inch iron rod set for a corner on the northwesterly boundary line of said Crestview Phase 3:

THENCE leaving said northwesterly boundary line of Crestview Phase 3 the following courses and distances as follows:

North 29 degrees 20 minutes 05 seconds West, a distance of 125.00 feet to a 1/2-inch iron rod set for corner:

South 60 degrees 39 minutes 55 seconds West, a distance of 140.76 feet to a 1/2-inch iron rod set for corner;

North 29 degrees 20 minutes 05 seconds West, a distance of 50.00 feet to a 1/2-inch iron rod set for corner;

North 60 degrees 39 minutes 55 seconds East, a distance of 5.90 feet to a 1/2-inch iron rod set for corner and the beginning of a non-tangent curve to the right;

Northerly, glong the curve to the right which has a chord that bears North 26 degrees 01 minutes 52 seconds West for 64.54 feet, a central angle of 06 degrees 36 minutes 25 seconds and a radius of 560.00 feet, for an arc distance of 64.58 feet to a 1/2-inch iron rod set for a corner and the end of said curve;

North 22 degrees 43 minutes 40 seconds West, a distance of 528.37 feet to a 1/2-inch iron rod set for corner and the beginning of a tangent curve to the right;

Northerly, along the curve to the right which has a chord that bears North 11 degrees 49 minutes 32 seconds West for 60.52 feet, a central angle of 21 degrees 48 minutes 16 seconds and a radius of 160.00 feet, for an arc distance of 60.89 feet to a 1/2-inch iron rod set for a corner and the end of said curve:

North 00 degrees 55 minutes 24 seconds West, a distance of 424.75 feet to a 1/2-inch iron rod set for corner and the beginning of a tangent curve to the left;

Northwesterly, along the curve to the left which has a chord that bears North 37 degrees 00 minutes 23 seconds West for 135.46 feet, a central angle of 72 degrees 09 minutes 59 seconds and a radius of 115.00 feet, for an arc distance of 144.85 feet to a 1/2-inch iron rod set for a corner and the end of said curve;

South 16 degrees 54 minutes 37 seconds West, a distance of 7.63 feet to a 1/2-inch iron rod set for corner;

North 73 degrees 05 minutes 23 seconds West, a distance of 50.00 feet to a 1/2-inch iron rod set for corner:

North 16 degrees 54 minutes 37 seconds East, a distance of 80.77 feet to a 1/2-inch iron rod set for corner and the beginning of a tangent curve to the right;

Northerly, along the curve to the right which has a chord that bears North 27 degrees 19 minutes 58 seconds East for 99.50 feet, a central angle of 20 degrees 50 minutes 42 seconds and a radius of 275.00 feet, for an arc distance of 100.05 feet to a 1/2-inch iron rod set for a corner and the end of said curve;

North 52 degrees 14 minutes 41 seconds West, a distance of 9.34 feet to a 1/2-inch iron rod set for corner;

North 37 degrees 45 minutes 19 seconds East, a distance of 50.00 feet to a 1/2-inch iron rod set for corner;

South 52 degrees 14 minutes 41 seconds East, a distance of 10.48 feet to a 1/2-inch iron rod set

North 37 degrees 45 minutes 19 seconds East, a distance of 125.00 feet to a 1/2-inch iron rod set for corner in the northerly boundary line of said 47.91 acre tract;

THENCE South 52 degrees 14 minutes 41 seconds East, along the northerly boundary of said 47.91 acre tract, a distance of 299.15 feet to a 1/2-inch iron rod set for a corner;

THENCE South 12 degrees 24 minutes 40 seconds East, continuing along the northerly boundary of said 47.91 acre tract, a distance of 175.56 feet to a 1/2-inch iron rod with cap found in the west line of Shores Clubhouse Phase, an addition to the City of Rockwall according to the plat thereof recorded in Cabinet A, Slide 310 of said Map Records;

THENCE South 00 degrees 55 minutes 24 seconds East, along the west line of said Shores Clubhouse Phase, a distance of 89.51 feet to a 1/2-inch iron rod with cap found for the beginning of a tangent curve to the left:

THENCE Southeasterly, along the curve to the left which has a chord that bears South 45 degrees 54 minutes 23 seconds East for 117.34 feet, a central angle of 89 degrees 57 minutes 58 seconds and a radius of 83.00 feet, for an arc distance of 130.33 feet to a 1/2-inch iron rod with cap found for the end of said curve;

THENCE North 89 degrees 06 minutes 38 seconds East, along the south line of said Shores Clubhouse Phase, a distance of 246.51 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING and containing 18.589 acres of land, more or less.

Where cited in the above description, "1/2" iron rod set", is a 1/2" iron rod with a plastic cap stamped DAA.

Basis for Bearings: Plat of Crestview Phase 3 recorded in Cabinet D, Slide 171 & 172 of the Map Records of Rockwall County, Texas.

NOW, THEREFORE, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS

WE the undersigned owners of the land shown on this plat, and designated herein as HILLSIDE PHASE 4 AT THE SHORES, subdivision to the City of Rockwall, Texas, and whose name is subscribed hereto, hereby dedicate for the use of the public forever all streets, alleys, parks, water courses, drains, easements and public places shown thereon for the purpose and consideration therein expressed. We further certify that all other parties who have a mortgage or lien interest in HILLSIDE PHASE 4 AT THE SHORES subdivision have been notified and signed this plat.

We understand and do hereby reserve the easement strips shown on this plat for the purposes stated and for the mutual use and accommodation of all utilities desiring to use or using same. We also understand the following:

1. No buildings shall be constructed or placed upon, over, or across the utility easements as described herein.

2. Any public utility shall have the right to remove and keep removed all or part of any buildings, fences, trees, shrubs, or other growths or improvements which in any way endanger or interfere with construction, maintenance or efficiency of their respective system on any of these easement strips; and any public utility shall at all times have the right of ingress or egress to, from and upon the said easement strips for purpose of construction, reconstruction, inspecting, patrolling, maintaining, and either adding to or removing all or part of their respective system without the necessity of, at any time, procuring the permission of anyone.

3. The City of Rockwall will not be responsible for any claims for any nature resulting from or occasioned by the establishment of grade of streets in the subdivision.

4. The developer and subdivision engineer shall bear total responsibility for storm drain improvements.

5. The developer shall be responsible for the necessary facilities to provide drainage patterns and drainage controls such that properties within the drainage area are not adversely affected by storm drainage from the development.

6. No fences, structures, or buildings in drainage easement without City permission. 7. No house, dwelling unit, or other structure shall be constructed on any lot in this addition by the owner or any other person until the developer and/or owner has complied with all requirements of the Subdivision Regulations of the City of Rockwall regarding improvements with respect to the entire block on the street or streets on which property abuts, including the actual installation of streets with the required base and paving, curb and gutter, water and sewer, drainage structures, storm structures, storm sewers, and alleys, all according to the specifications of the City of Rockwall; or

Until an escrow deposit, sufficient to pay for the cost of such improvements, as determined by the city's engineer and/or city administrator, computed on a private commercial rate basis, has been made with the city secretary, accompanied by an agreement signed by the developer and/or owner. authorizing the city to make such improvements at prevailing private commercial rates, or have the same made by a contractor and pay for the same out of the escrow deposit, should the developer and/or owner fail or refuse to install the required improvements within the time stated in such written agreement, but in no case shall the City be obligated to make such improvements itself. Such deposit may be used by the owner and/or developer as progress payments as the work progresses in making such improvements by making certified requisitions to the city secretary. supported by evidence of work done; or

Until the developer and/or owner files a corporate surety bond with the city secretary in a sum equal to the cost of such improvements for the designated area, guaranteeing the installation thereof within the time stated in the bond, which time shall be fixed by the city council of the City of Rockwall.

We further acknowledge that the dedications and/or exactions made herein are proportional to the impact of the subdivision upon the public services required in order that the development will comport with the present and future growth needs of the City; We, our successors and assigns hereby waive any claim, damage, or cause of action that we may have as a result of the dedication of exactions made herein.
