WHEREAS, Kenneth and Inez Smith are the owners of a tract of land in the County of Rockwall, State of Texas, said tract being described as follows;

Being, a tract of land situated in the B.F. Boydstun Survey, Abstract No. 14, City of Rockwall, Rockwall County, Texas, and futher being that tract as Recorded in Volume 151, Page 352, Deed Records of Rockwall County, Texas, and being more particularly described as follows;

Beginning, at the point of intersection of the west line of Tyler Street, with the south line of East Rusk Street, a iron stake for corner;

Thence, S. 0° 14' 21" E., along the west line of Tyler Street, a distance of 100.00 feet to a iron stake for corner; Thence, West, leaving the said west line of Tyler Street, a distance of 93.70 feet to a iron stake for corner; Thence, N. 2° 51' 19" W., a distance of 100.12 feet to a point on the south line of East Rusk Street, a iron stake for corner;

Thence, East, along the south line of East Rusk Street, a distance of 98.27 feet to the PLACE OF BEGINNING, and containing 0.220 acres of land.

NOW THEREFORE KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

THAT, Kenneth and Inez Smith, being owners does hereby adopt this plat designating the herein above described property as Mick Addition to the City of Rockwall, Rockwall County, Texas, and does hereby dedicate to the public use forever the streets and alleys shown thereon and does hereby reserve the right-of-way and easement strips shown on this plat for the purposes stated and for the mutal use and accommodation of all utilities desiring to use or using same, any public utility shall have the right to remove and keep removed all or part of any buildings, fences, trees, shrubs or other growths or improvements which in any way endanger or interfere with construction, maintenance or efficiency of their respective systems on any of the right-of-way and easement strips; and any public utility shall have the right of ingress and egress to, from and upon the said right-of-way and easement strips for the purpose of construction, reconstruction, patrolling, maintaining and either adding to or removing all or part of their respective systems without the necessity of at any time procuring the permission of anyone. The City of Rockwall will not be responsible for any claims of any nature resulting from or occasioned by the establishments of grades of streets in this addition.
