THENCE Southerly, along said curve to the left, an arc distance of 33.24 feet to a 1/2 inch iron rod with a yellow plastic cap stamped "DAA" found for corner at the beginning of a curve to the right having a central angle of 20 deg. 32 min. 23 sec., a radius of 288.50 feet and a chord bearing and distance of South 11 deg. 07 min. 47 sec. West, 102.87 feet;

THENCE Southerly, along said curve to the right, an arc distance of 103.42 feet to a 1/2 inch iron rod with a yellow plastic cap stamped "DAA" found for corner at the beginning of a curve to the right having a central angle of 06 deg. 26 min. 03 sec., a radius of 545.00 feet and a chord bearing and distance of South 24 deg. 37 min. 00 sec. West, 61.17 feet;

THENCE Southerly, along said curve to the right, an arc distance of 61.20 feet to a 1/2 inch iron rod with a yellow plastic cap stamped "DAA" found for corner;

THENCE South 27 deg. 50 min. 01 sec. West, a distance of 60.55 feet to a 1/2 inch iron rod with a yellow plastic cap stamped "DAA" found for corner at the beginning of a curve to the left having a central angle of 15 deg. 01 min. 45 sec., a radius of 800.00 feet and a chord bearing and distance of South 20 deg. 19 min. 08 sec. West, 209.25 feet;

THENCE Southerly, along said curve to the left, an arc distance of 209.85 feet to a 1/2 inch iron rod with a yellow plastic cap stamped "DAA" found at the Northeast corner of SHORES NORTH PHASE 5, an Addition to the City of Rockwall, Rockwall County, Texas, according to the Plat thereof recorded in Cabinet E, Slide 43, Plat Records, Rockwall County, Texas;

Petersen, Jr. and wife, Sandra Petersen, recorded in Volume 240, Page 595, Deed Records Rockwall County, Texas, passing at a distance of 677.76 feet the Northwest corner of the Mason-Steed Addition, an Addition to the City of Rockwall, Rockwall County, Texas, according to the Plat thereof recorded in Cabinet C, Slide 177, Plat Records, Rockwall County, Texas, continuing a total distance of 1141.05 feet to a 1/2 inch iron rod with a yellow plastic cap stamped "DAA" found at the Northeast corner of a tract of land described in Deed to Engle Homes/Texas, Inc., recorded in Volume 2000, Page 95, Deed Records, Rockwall County, Texas;

THENCE Westerly, along the North line of said Engle Homes tract the following four (4) courses and distances: North 88 deg. 41 min. 02 sec. West, a distance of 44.68 feet to a 1/2 inch iron rod with a yellow plastic cap stamped "DAA" found for corner;

THENCE North 74 deg. 31 min. 52 sec. West, a distance of 246.59 feet to a 1/2 inch iron rod with a yellow plastic cap stamped "DAA" found for corner;

THENCE North 44 deg. 57 min. 33 sec. West, a distance of 261.62 feet to a 1/2 inch iron rod with a yellow plastic cap stamped "DAA" found for corner;

THENCE South 82 deg. 13 min. 40 sec. West, a distance of 99.50 feet to a 1/2 inch iron rod with a yellow plastic cap stamped "DAA" found for corner in the East line of Shores Boulevard, a variable width public right-of-way, as established by Plat of said SHORES NORTH PHASE ONE Addition, said point being in a non-tangent curve to the left having a central angle of 04 deg. 21 min. 07 sec., a radius of 810.00 feet and a chord bearing and distance of North 09 deg. 56 min. 54 sec. East, a distance of 60.55 feet to a 1/2 inch iron rod with a yellow plastic cap stamped "DAA" found for corner at the beginning of a curve to the left having a central angle of 08 deg. 00 min. 06 sec., a radius of 605.00 feet and a chord bearing and distance of North 23 deg. 49 min. 58

THENCE Northeasterly, along said curve to the left, an arc distance of 84.49 feet to a 1/2 inch iron rod with a yellow plastic cap stamped "DAA" found for corner at the beginning of a curve to the right having a central angle of 06 deg. 29 min. 44 sec., a radius of 288.50 feet and a chord bearing and distance of North 23 deg. 04 min. 47 sec. THENCE Northeasterly, along said curve to the left, an arc distance of 105.22 feet to a 1/2 inch iron rod with a yellow plastic cap stamped "DAA" found for corner at the beginning of a curve to the left having a central angle of 6 deg. 58 min. 31 sec., a radius of 616.50 feet and a chord bearing and distance of North 03 deg. 29 min. 09 sec. East, 75.01 feet;

THENCE Northeasterly, along said curve to the left, an arc distance of 75.05 feet to a 1/2 inch iron rod with a yellow plastic cap stamped "DAA" found for corner;

THENCE North 00 deg. 00 min. 07 sec. West, a distance of 5.00 feet to a 1/2 inch iron rod with a yellow plastic cap stamped "DAA" found for corner in the South line of said Dalton Road;

NOW, THEREFORE, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

WE the undersigned owners of the land shown on this plat, and designated herein as SHORES NORTH PHASE 6, an addition to the City of Rockwall, Texas, and whose name is subscribed hereto, hereby dedicate to the use of the public forever all streets, alleys, parks, water courses, drains, easements and public places thereon shown for the purpose and consideration therein expressed. We further certify that all other parties who have a mortgage or lien interest in SHORES NORTH PHASE 6 have been notified and signed this plat.

We understand and do hereby reserve the easement strips shown on this plat for the purposes stated and for the mutual use and accommodation of all utilities desiring to use or using same. We also understand the

 No buildings shall be constructed or placed upon, over, or across the utility easements as described herein. 2. Any public utility shall have the right to remove and keep removed all or part of any buildings, fences, trees, shrubs, or other growths or improvements which in any way endanger or interfere with construction, maintenance or efficiency of their respective system on any of these easement strips; and any public utility shall at all times have the right of ingress or egress to, from and upon the said easement strips for purpose of construction, reconstruction, inspecting, patrolling, maintaining, and either adding to or removing all or part of their respective system without the necessity of, at any time, procuring the permission of anyone. 3. The City of Rockwall will not be responsible for any claims of any nature resulting from or occasioned by the establishment of grade of streets in the subdivision.

4. The developer and subdivision engineer shall bear total responsibility for storm drain improvements. 5. The developer shall be responsible for the necessary facilities to provide drainage patterns and drainage controls such that properties within the drainage area are not adversely affected by storm drainage from the

6. No fences can be built within the 10'x10' Sidewalk and Visibility Easements at all alley intersections. 7. No retaining walls exceeding 2.0' in height shall be built within the 10'x10' Sidewalk and Visibility Easements at all alley intersections.

8. No house, dwelling unit, or other structure shall be constructed on any lot in this addition by the owner or any other person until the developer and/or owner has complied with all requirements of the Subdivision Regulations of the City of Rockwall regarding improvements with respect to the entire block on the street or streets on which property abuts, including the actual installation of streets with the required base and paving, curb and gutter, water and sewer, drainage structures, storm structures, storm sewers, and alleys, all according to the specifications of the City of Rockwall; or

Until an escrow deposit, sufficient to pay for the cost of such improvements, as determined by the city's engineer and/or city administrator, computed on a private commercial rate basis, has been made with the city secretary, accompanied by an agreement signed by the developer and/or owner, authorizing the city to make such improvements at prevailing private commercial rates, or have the same made by a contractor and pay for the same out of the escrow deposit, should the developer and/or owner fail or refuse to install the required improvements within the time stated in such written agreement, but in no case shall the City be obligated to make such improvements itself. Such deposit may be used by the owner and/or developer as progress payments as the work progresses in making such improvements by making certified requisitions to the city secretary, supported by evidence of work done; or

Until the developer and/or owner files a corporate surety bond with the city secretary in a sum equal to the cost of such improvements for the designated area, guaranteeing the installation thereof within the time stated in the bond, which time shall be fixed by the city council of the City of Rockwall.

We further acknowledge that the dedications and/or exactions made herein are proportional to the impact of the subdivision upon the public services required in order that the development will comport with the present and future growth needs of the City; We, our successors and assigns hereby waive any claim, damage, or cause of action that we may have as a result of the dedication of exactions made herein.




